Anne Mayes left this world to be with her Lord and Savior on November 6, 2007 at 6:30 p.m. after being diagnosed with Stage IV Non Small Cell Carcinoma in August of this year. She passed away at M.D. Anderson Cancer Center where she was receiving treatment.

Anne Mayes, better know as “Annie O” of AO Custom Cues was a local Houston cue-maker who was also part owner of the Heart of Texas Tour and played on the Women’s Professional Billiards Tour in the 80’s and early 90s. She was a beloved member of Houston’s billiard community and her talent and vision for creating custom cues will not soon be forgotten. Ms. Mayes was a major contributor to the women’s division of the Fast Eddie’s Tour; a league operator; sponsor; and instructor. So many people loved Annie for who she was; a kind- hearted, generous soul; a cue artisan; a player; a bird lover; a person who never met a stranger. Her absence will leave a void inside us all, but we can always remember how she loved to shout, “Oh Annie” when she would miss a shot or play bad position at the table; remember her “kewl beans!”; and of course her favorite rhetoric when introducing herself, “the lovely and wonderful, sexy, adorable, beautiful and talented Anne Mayes”.

Anne is survived by an only daughter Rachelle Hodges; son-n-law Brian; and grandsons Matthew and Owen, 3 ½ years old and 7 months old respectively. She also leaves behind her beloved birds Roger and Crimson who I am sure will miss her very much.
