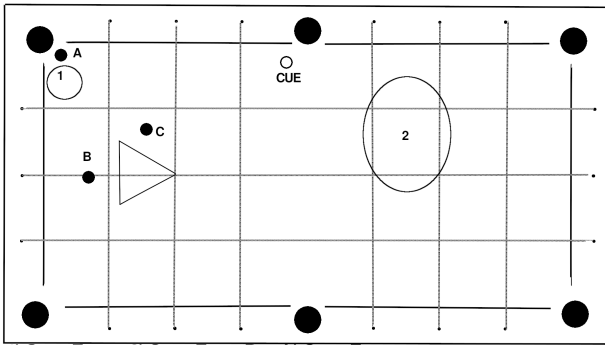

Quiz 358 is about learning how to hit on different sides of the ball. Position at cue and pocket A. Your goal is to land in target 1, or the left side of B. The shot on B requires more stroke than A. Playing B to get position in target 2, has two requirements. The angle on B can't be flat and the stroke needs power.

Break the rack open using C. These shots are designed to develop your stroke sensitivity to different cut shots. Champions in training struggle with playing a shot within its stroke power limits. Champions will also miss those shots in competition, know when and how to challenge an opponent with cut shots.



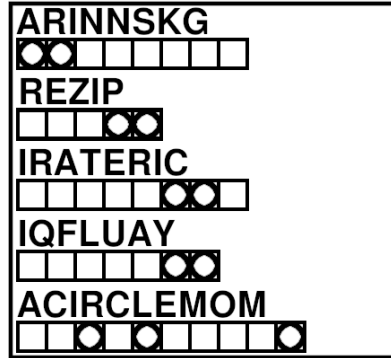

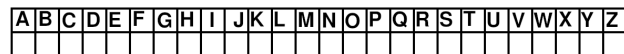
