To whom it may concern,

After making an in-depth inspection, the cue described below is determined to be an original Gus Szamboti cue that was built in the early to mid 1970's.

DESCRIPTION: All measurements are approximate.

- Stainless steel joint, 5/16x14 stainless joint screw with Black trim collars and a wide (.070) Maple trim ring with an eight index of Black veneers.
- Birdseye Maple forearm with four inner points of Ebony and veneers of double black, Lyme green and natural.
- Wrap is green spec Irish linen.
- Butt sleeve is Black Ebony, three inches in length including veneers above the butt cap with double White in the center, green on each side and black on each side.
- Butt cap is Milk White Delrin at 1 and 3/8 inches in length with a black rubber bumper secured with an Allen screw.
- The butt is 28.50 inches in length and its weight is 15.85 ounces.
- Two original Szamboti shafts, both at a full 12.75MM @ 28.50 inches in length. One weighs 4.05 ounces and the other 3.85 ounces. Each have one-inch-long Ivory ferrules.
- Cue is straight and sound and in good used condition.
